State of Play

On Tuesday 8 August, the Senate resolved 31/31 to deny a mandatory plebiscite that would have given the Australian people a vote on whether Australia's marriage law should be changed. This 31/31 decision resulted in the compulsory plebiscite being replaced with a voluntary survey of public opinion. This is a very serious question that can change the culture of our nation for generations.
